Spread of COVID-19	Participants to be aware of the current Government restrictions as any given point in time. To be displayed on club website. Participants and families to take personal responsibility for meeting these restrictions in their everyday life to protect themselves and their team mates/coaches Self-assessment to be undertaken prior to training, Players who are unwell or have been in contact with someone with suspected or confirmed COVID to stay away and advise their coaches. <p>Football in the heart of the community</p>	<p>Participants to ensure they adhere to regulations in place around travel to and from fixtures.</p> <p>Kick off times will be staggered to minimise the number of people in the park, car park and surrounding areas.</p> <p>Only managers/adults to access changing rooms to collect equipment.</p> <p>Players to be reminded of good hand hygiene, before, during and after matches</p> <p>2m distancing to be maintained wherever possible, by all participants when not in match play.</p> <p>Only players expected to participate in the game should attend.</p> <p>Any shared equipment should be sanitized on regular basis.</p> <p>Only one parent per child is permitted to stay for safeguarding purposes. Appropriate distancing MUST be adhered to on the side lines.</p>

<p>Football in the heart of the community</p>	<p>Each team will have a responsible adult who will politely remind spectators to comply and will ensure NHS Track and Trace is used</p> <p>Respect barriers will be placed 2m from the side line</p> <p>Parents to prepare children for the altered environment.</p> <p>Physical contact to be avoided, (No handshakes/hi 5)</p> <p>Players will refrain from spitting/clearing nasal cavities</p> <p>All players to bring named water bottles and hand sanitiser</p>		
<p>Children leaving site</p>	<p>Parents to drop and collect child from coach/manager (from 2 m)</p> <p>Additional adult to be on hand to assist with supervision.</p> <p>There will be no changing facilities, so players should arrived dressed ready to play.</p>	<p>Minor</p>	

Football in the heart of the community	Toilet facilities will be available 30 minutes before and 30 minutes after a game. Social Distancing should be observed when accessing toilets, good hand hygiene/washing/gel to be used.		
Other park users	Players to be aware of surroundings. Coaches to monitor vicinity for over crowding	Minor	
Injury	Area to be inspected for dangerous articles (glass/needles/dog poo) First aid bag to be available at all times. First aid to be administered within family bubbles if possible. If not possible the first aider is to wear gloves and mask whilst administering Additional adult to assist	Minor	

<p>Contact in play</p>	<p>Social distancing to be observed between contact sessions / Hand sanitizer to be used at beginning and end of each session by all involved.</p> <p>Any shared equipment (i.e balls goal post) should be sanitized at regular intervals. Ball to be cleaned regularly throughout the game.</p>	<p>Minor</p>	
<p>Matches</p>	<p>Players should arrive to matches within their own household bubble only.</p> <p>Players to arrive ready to with no need to change and with their own drinks and coats.</p> <p>All players should follow social distancing guidelines while carrying out warm ups and team talks. And will sanitize their hands.</p> <p>Coaches and substitutes should remain at 2m distance while on side line. Should parents require face masks for substitutes they will provide at their own discretion, although they will not be permitted during game time.</p>		

No handshakes will take place with opposition / match officials at this time.

Goal celebrations should be kept to a minimum.

All players and coaches to hand sanitize at the end of the game.

Only one parent per child is permitted to remain. Appropriate distancing must be adhered to on the side lines.

All adults attending are requested to use the Track and Trace QR Codes provided within the park. Team sheets will be used to provide a record of participating children.

Respect barrier will be 2metres away from the pitch not 1 metre.

Players and parents should not congregate post match
